Please do not feel embarrassed about noise or hyperactivity - it's a joy that they are here.

Other activities and groups involve a Ladies Group, Prayer Group, S.V.P., Quiz Nights and Social Committee. Please feel free to enquire about any activity within our Parish, or indeed any plans about what you wish to introduce.
